3 In the report:

4 On page 36 of the report, strike everything under the heading "Family Planning/Reproductive
5 Health" and insert:

6 "The Committee recommends a total of not less than \$622,500,000 in the Act for family
7 planning and reproductive health programs, including \$544,000,000 under this heading,
8 \$41,000,000 under the ESF heading, and \$37,500,000 for the United Nations Population Fund.
9 The Committee recognizes that information and assistance for families interested in healthy
10 timing and spacing of pregnancies can enhance maternal and child health and improve the
11 chances of survival of women and children."

12 In the table entitled "Global Health Programs" on page 34 of the report, under "Family
13 Planning and Reproductive Health" strike \$461,000,000 and insert "\$544,000,000" and make
14 corresponding changes to the table.

15 In the table entitled "Economic Support Fund" on pages 44-45 of the report, at the appropriate
16 place insert the following new line: "Family Planning and Reproductive Health (non-add within
17 country funds).....41,000".

18 In the table entitled "International Organizations and Programs" on page 61 of the report,
19 insert the following new line: "U.N. Population Fund.....37,500" and make
20 corresponding changes to the report table and text.

21 In the table entitled "Economic Support Fund" on page 45, strike "Unallocated.....37,500"
22 and make corresponding changes to the report table and text.

23 In the bill:

24 On page 40, line 22, strike "\$3,997,196,000" and insert "\$3,959,696,000".

25 On page 60, line 9, strike "\$315,500,000" and insert "\$353,000,000".

26 On page 162, lines 12 and 13, strike "child survival, malaria, and tuberculosis" and insert
27 "other global health and child survival activities".

28 On page 275, strike lines 9 through 19, and insert the following:

29 INTERNATIONAL FAMILY PLANNING AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

30 Sec. 7056. (a) ASSISTANCE FOR FOREIGN NONGOVERNMENTAL
31 ORGANIZATIONS.—The Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2151 et seq.) is amended
32 by inserting after section 104C the following:

33 "SEC. 104D. ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE.

34 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law, regulation, or policy, in determining eligibility
35 for assistance authorized under sections 104, 104A, 104B, and 104C, a foreign nongovernmental

1 organization—

2 “(1) shall not be ineligible for such assistance solely on the basis of health or medical
3 services, including counseling and referral services, provided by such organization with
4 non-United States Government funds if such services—

5 “(A) are permitted in the country in which they are being provided; and

6 “(B) would not violate United States law if provided in the United States; and

7 “(2) shall not be subject to requirements relating to the use of non-United States
8 Government funds for advocacy and lobbying activities other than those that apply to
9 United States nongovernmental organizations receiving assistance under this part.”.

10 (b) UNITED NATIONS POPULATION FUND.—

11 (1) CONTRIBUTION.—Of the funds appropriated by this Act under the heading
12 “International Organizations and Programs”, not less than \$37,500,000 shall be made
13 available for the United Nations Population Fund (referred to in this subsection as
14 “UNFPA”).

15 (2) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Funds appropriated for UNFPA under this Act that are not
16 made available for UNFPA because of the operation of any provision of law—

17 (A) shall be transferred to, and merged with funds, appropriated under the heading
18 “Global Health Programs”; and

19 (B) shall be made available for family planning, maternal, and reproductive health
20 activities, subject to the regular notification procedures of the Committees on
21 Appropriations.

22 (3) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS IN CHINA.—None of the funds made available under
23 this Act may be used by UNFPA for a country program in the People’s Republic of China.

24 (4) CONDITIONS ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Funds made available under this Act for
25 UNFPA may not be made available unless—

26 (A) UNFPA maintains funds received under this Act in an account separate from
27 other UNFPA accounts and does not commingle such funds with other funds; and

28 (B) UNFPA does not fund abortions.

29 On page 279, lines 11 and 12, strike “bilateral assistance for child survival activities or
30 disease” and insert “global health”.

31 On page 279, beginning on line 19, strike “not more than” and all that follows through line 21,
32 and insert the following: “not less than \$585,000,000 shall be made available for family planning
33 and reproductive health activities, including in areas where population growth threatens
34 biodiversity and endangered species.”.
