15 16	(2) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Funds appropriated for UNFPA under this Act that are no made available for UNFPA because of the operation of any provision of law—
17 18	(A) shall be transferred to, and merged with funds, appropriated under the heading "Global Health Programs"; and
19 20 21	(B) shall be made available for family planning, maternal, and reproductive health activities, subject to the regular notification procedures of the Committees on Appropriations.
22 23	(3) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS IN CHINA.—None of the funds made available under this Act may be used by UNFPA for a country program in the People's Republic of China.
24 25	(4) CONDITIONS ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Funds made available under this Act for UNFPA may not be made available unless—
26 27	(A) UNFPA maintains funds received under this Act in an account separate from other UNFPA accounts and does not commingle such funds with other funds; and
28	(B) UNFPA does not fund abortions.
29 30	On page 279, lines 11 and 12, strike "bilateral assistance for child survival activities or disease" and insert "global health".
31 32 33 34	On page 279, beginning on line 19, strike "not more than" and all that follows through line 21 and insert the following: "not less than \$585,000,000 shall be made available for family planning and reproductive health activities, including in areas where population growth threatens biodiversity and endangered species.".
