Viz:

1 On page 157, lines 11 and 12, strike “child survival,
2 malaria, and tuberculosis” and insert “other global health
3 and child survival activities”.

4 On page 273, lines 17 and 18, strike “bilateral assist-
5 ance for child survival activities or disease” and insert
6 “global health,”.

7 On page 274, beginning on line 1, strike “not more
8 than \$461,000,000” and all that follows through line 10

1 and insert the following: “not less than \$585,000,000
2 shall be made available for family planning/reproductive
3 health, including in areas where population growth threat-
4 ens biodiversity or endangered species.”.

5 On page 327, strike line 14 and all that follows
6 through page 328, line 2, and insert the following:

9 SEC. 7063. (a) UNITED NATIONS POPULATION
10 FUND.—

11 (1) CONTRIBUTION.—Of the amounts made
12 available under the heading “INTERNATIONAL ORGA-
13 NIZATIONS AND PROGRAMS” in this Act for fiscal
14 year 2017, \$37,500,000 shall be made available for
15 the United Nations Population Fund (referred to in
16 this section as “UNFPA”).

17 (2) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Amounts appro-
18 priated under this Act for UNFPA that are not
19 made available for UNFPA because of the operation
20 of any provision of law shall be transferred to the
21 “GLOBAL HEALTH PROGRAMS” account and shall be
22 made available for family planning, maternal, and
23 reproductive health activities, subject to the regular
24 notification procedures of the Committee on Appro-

1 appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on Ap-
2 propriations of the House of Representatives.

3 (3) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS IN
4 CHINA.—None of the amounts made available under
5 this Act may be used by UNFPA for a country pro-
6 gram in the People's Republic of China.

7 (4) CONDITIONS ON AVAILABILITY OF
8 FUNDS.—Amounts made available under this Act for
9 UNFPA may not be made available unless—

10 (A) UNFPA maintains such amounts in
11 an account that is separate from other UNFPA
12 accounts and does not commingle such funds
13 with other funds; and

14 (B) UNFPA does not fund abortions.

15 (b) ASSISTANCE FOR FOREIGN NONGOVERNMENTAL
16 ORGANIZATIONS.—The Foreign Assistance Act of 1961
17 (22 U.S.C. 2151 et seq.) is amended by inserting after
18 section 104C the following:

19 **“SEC. 104D. ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE.**

20 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, regula-
21 tion, or policy, in determining eligibility for assistance
22 under sections 104, 104A, 104B, and 104C, a foreign non-
23 governmental organization—

24 “(1) shall not be ineligible for such assistance
25 solely on the basis of health or medical services, in-

1 cluding counseling and referral services, provided by
2 such organization with non-United States Govern-
3 ment funds if such services—

4 “(A) are permitted in the country in which
5 they are being provided; and

6 “(B) would not violate United States law if
7 provided in the United States; and

8 “(2) shall not be subject to requirements relat-
9 ing to the use of non-United States Government
10 funds for advocacy and lobbying activities other than
11 those that apply to United States nongovernmental
12 organizations receiving assistance under this part.”.

Amendment to the report to be offered by Senators

Make the following changes to the report:

In the table entitled "Global Health Programs" on page 57 of the report, on the "Family Planning and Reproductive Health" line, strike "461,000" and insert "544,000".

In the table entitled "Global Health Programs" on page 58 of the report, strike "Unallocated.....83,000".

On page 59 of the report strike everything under the heading "Family Planning/Reproductive Health" and insert:

"The Committee recommends a total of \$622,500,000 in the act for family planning and reproductive health programs, including \$544,000,000 under this heading, \$41,000,000 under the ESF heading, and \$37,500,000 for the United Nations Population Fund."

In the table entitled "International Organizations and Programs" on page 94 of the report, on the "Unallocated" line, strike "47,500" and insert "10,000", and insert the following new line: "U.N. Population Fund.....37,500".
