AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MURPHY

Viz:

1 At the appropriate place in “Title II—General Provi-  
2 sions” of the bill, insert the following:

3 SEC. 208. For an additional amount for “Govern-  
4 ment Accountability Office, Salaries and Expenses”,  
5 \$30,000,000.

6 SEC. 209. For an additional amount for “Architect  
7 of the Capitol, Capitol Building”, \$1,700,000, to remain  
8 available until September 30, 2022; for an additional  
9 amount for “Architect of the Capitol, Library Buildings  
10 and Grounds”, \$13,600,000, to remain available until  
11 September 30, 2022; and for an additional amount for  
12 “Architect of the Capitol, Capitol Police Buildings,

1 Grounds, and Security”, \$9,700,000, to remain available  
2 until September 30, 2022.

3 SEC. 210. For an additional amount for “Govern-  
4 ment Accountability Office, Salaries and Expenses”,  
5 \$5,300,000; for “Congressional Budget Office, Salaries  
6 and Expenses”, \$500,000; for an additional amount for  
7 “Library of Congress, Salaries and Expenses”,  
8 \$6,000,000; for an additional amount for “Capitol Police,  
9 General Expenses”, \$3,900,000; and for an additional  
10 amount for “Architect of the Capitol, Capital Construction  
11 and Operations”, \$4,300,000, to remain available until  
12 September 30, 2022: *Provided*, That upon approval of the  
13 Senate and House Committees on Appropriations, the Ar-  
14 chitect of the Capitol may reprogram such additional  
15 amounts among any appropriation provided for the Archi-  
16 tect of the Capitol.

17 SEC. 211. For an additional amount for “Senate,  
18 Senators’ Official Personnel and Office Expense Ac-  
19 count”, \$20,000,000; and for additional amount for “Sen-  
20 ate, Miscellaneous Items”, \$5,000,000: *Provided*, That  
21 such additional funds provided for “Senate, Senators’ Of-  
22 ficial Personnel and Office Expense Account” shall be dis-  
23 tributed in such a manner as would have been distributed  
24 in fiscal year 2011 and each subsequent year if funding  
25 reductions to the levels authorized in current law (2

1 U.S.C. 4571, 2 U.S.C. 6314, and 2 U.S.C. 4575) had not  
2 been in effect.

3 SEC. 212. No part of any appropriation contained in  
4 this title shall be made available for obligation or expendi-  
5 ture, nor any authority granted herein be effective, until  
6 the enactment into law of a subsequent Act entitled “Bi-  
7 partisan Budget Act of 2017”.
