8 For an additional amount for “Railroad Safety
9 Grants”, \$50,000,000, of which \$25,000,000 shall be
10 made available to carry out 49 U.S.C. 20158; and,
11 \$25,000,000 shall be made available for projects as de-
12 fined in section 22501 of title 49.

13 CAPITAL AND DEBT SERVICE GRANTS TO THE NATIONAL
14 RAILROAD PASSENGER CORPORATION

15 For an additional amount for “Capital and Debt
16 Service Grants to the National Railroad Passenger Cor-
17 poration”, \$610,000,000, of which \$555,000,000 shall be
18 made available until expended for state-of-good repair
19 backlog and infrastructure improvements on Northeast
20 Corridor shared-use infrastructure identified in the North-
21 east Corridor Infrastructure and Operations Advisory
22 Commission’s approved 5-year capital plan.

1 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION

2 CAPITAL INVESTMENT GRANTS

3 For an additional amount for “Capital Investment
4 Grants”, \$1,310,000,000.

5 DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
6 DEVELOPMENT

7 PUBLIC AND INDIAN HOUSING

8 TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE

9 For an additional amount for “Tenant-Based Rental
10 Assistance”, \$37,500,000 shall be for incremental rental
11 voucher assistance for victims of domestic violence, dating
12 violence, sexual assault, or stalking, as defined by the Vio-
13 lence Against Women Act Reauthorization Act of 2013
14 (Public Law 113–4), who require an emergency transfer.

15 PUBLIC HOUSING CAPITAL FUND

16 For an additional amount for “Public Housing Cap-
17 ital Fund”, \$227,500,000.

18 COMMUNITY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

19 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND

20 For an additional amount for “Community Develop-
21 ment Fund”, \$100,000,000.

22 HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM

23 For an additional amount for “HOME Investment
24 Partnerships Program”, \$990,000,000.

1 CHOICE NEIGHBORHOODS INITIATIVE

2 For an additional amount for “Choice Neighborhoods
3 Initiative”, \$100,000,000, of which not less than
4 \$100,000,000 shall be awarded to public housing agencies.

6 HOMES

7 LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION

8 For an additional amount for “Office of Lead Hazard
9 Control and Healthy Homes Lead Hazard Reduction”,
10 \$10,000,000.

11 ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISION

12 SEC. 501. No part of any appropriation contained in
13 this title shall be made available for obligation or expendi-
14 ture, nor any authority granted herein be effective, until
15 the enactment into law of a subsequent Act entitled “Bi-
16 partisan Budget Act of 2015”.
