Sponsor	Bill or Report	Topic	Summary
Harkin	Report	Housing accessibility	Requires HUD to work with the US Access Board to analyze and develop recommendations on how to increase accessibility to housing for people with disabilities and report to the Committee.
Murkowski	Bill	Continued access to mortgage insurance for homes with alternative water sources	Allows the HUD Secretary to provide an exception in regulation, instead of relying on annual waivers, that will allow homes with alternative water systems that meet state and local codes that ensure health and safety standards to obtain FHA insurance.
Pryor/Boozman	Bill	Disaster Assistance for small communities	Provides the Secretary with the authority to make disaster assistance available to smaller, non-entitlement communities from existing funds.
Coats	Report	National Roadside Survey	Requires NHTSA to report the details of the survey methodology and directs GAO to review the value of the program.
Mikulski	Report	RAD conversion	Encourages public housing authorities participating in RAD to give current employees that lose their jobs the right of first refusal on employment positions.
Coons	Report	Recent emergencies	In a discussion of recent emergencies that affect roads and bridges, adds a mention of the damage to the I-813 bridge in Delaware.
Johnson	Bill/Report	Transit Technical Assistance	Shifts \$2 million from transit new starts oversight activities to increase funding for transit technical assistance from \$3 million to \$5 million.
Landrieu	Report	PHMSA Integrity Management Program	Encourages PHMSA to move forward with a proposed rule to strengthen pipeline integrity management standards.
Coats	Report	Crimea	Prohibits funds in the act from being used to recognize the sovereignty of the Russian Federation over Crimea.
Landrieu	Bill/Report	Small Scale LNG Liquefaction Facilities	Directs PHMSA to modernize regulations for the siting of Small Scale Liquefaction Facilities that package LNG for use in vehicles and vessels

Hoeven	Report	Unmanned aerial systems (UAS)	Encourages the FAA to study how the Air Force conducts routine UAS operations.
Hoeven	Report	Unmanned aerial systems (UAS)	Encourages the FAA to consider using recently designated test sites if they would help the agency make determinations about whether to approve UAS, as authorized under section 333 of the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012.
Murkowski	Report	Statewide planning in Alaska	Simplifies language in the report related statewide transportation planning in the State of Alaska.
